For the first time, Dasha will compete at the Winter Games in cross-country skiing. She won 3 of 4 Olympic selection races and ranked 12<sup>th</sup> at the sprint classic during the World Cup in Estonia in January.

#### Valérie Maltais, Short-track Speed Skating

Valérie will be competing in Olympic Games for the first time. She won 4 bronze medals at the relay on the 2009–2010 World Cup circuit. At the Olympic selections, she respectively ranked 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> at the 1500m, 1000m and 500m.

#### Dominique Maltais, Snowboard

Olympic bronze medallist at the 2006 Turin Games, Dominique won the bronze medal at the last World Cup event in Stoneham, Québec, last January 21<sup>st</sup>. She is ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> on the World circuit.
